

Elm Street Books event:

Plastic surgeon to discuss rejuvenation guide Saturday

Dr. Neil A. Gordon, local facial plastic and reconstructive surgeon, will sign copies of the new book "Your Complete Guide to Facial Rejuvenation," from noon to 3 p.m. Saturday, September 29, at Elm Street Books, 35 Elm Street.

Dr. Gordon, who is based in Wilton and Greenwich only performs surgery on the face and neck. He is recognized throughout the country for his expertise

in the most sophisticated techniques and is one of five doctors who collaborated on the book.

His specialty is the revolutionary Deep-Plane Facelift, which involves repositioning the underlying facial tissues rather than just the skin. The technique is said to offer "longer lasting results with no pain after surgery, and none of the unnatural tightening and pulling of the

skin that is seen in obsolete techniques," according to a press release.

Dr. Gordon founded The Retreat at Split-Rock in Wilton, which combines a plastic surgery facility with a spa, where patients can be cared for after a procedure is performed.

Dr. Gordon is chairman of The Committee on Patient Safety and Accreditation for the American Academy

of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He is also a clinical instructor of surgery in the Department of Residency Education in the Division of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He is one of the few surgeons to achieve double board certification by both the American Board of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and the American Board of Otolaryngology.
